The golf season is approaching faster than we realize so it is time to update our members about plans for the coming golf season. Our newly formed golf committee is now working on the upcoming year. As we continue to meet, we hope to provide details with this newsletter.

MEMBERSHIP AND PACKAGE OPTIONS:

Full Membership:

Unlimited golf, unrestricted tee times that can be booked a week in advance.

Membership categories – subject to paying \$400.00 per family membership fee:

First Adult Golf:	\$900.00
Second Adult Golf:	\$600.00
Intermediate (living at home 19-24)	\$450.00
Junior (12-18)	\$200.00
Junior (under 12)	\$125.00

NOTE: All Junior tee times are restricted. Also, prices are subject to GST and MGA fees.

Seasonal Member (Associate):

Restricted tee times, tee times booked three days in advance.

Junior (under 19)	\$225.00
Intermediate (19-24)	\$500.00

Golf Packages with Membership:

Unrestricted tee times that can be booked a week in advance. Subject to paying \$400.00 per family membership fees. This will entitle the member to play in all club events, as well as represent the Club in outside events.

12 Games of 18 holes:	\$350.00

Golf Package without Membership:

Restricted tee times that can be booked three days in advance.

12 Games of 18 holes:	\$380.00

Ladies Night Only Packages without Membership:

Tee times 3:30-6:00 on Ladies Night, can be booked three days in advance.

12 Games of 9 holes:	\$235.00
12 Games of 18 holes:	\$380.00

SINGLE GAME GREEN FEES:

18 holes: \$35.00

9 holes: \$21.00

Unless accompanied by a member, tee off in restricted tee times:

10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

Monday to Friday

12:00 noon to dusk

Saturday and Sunday
