Golf Membership or Golf Package?

Do you like to play golf at least twice a week? Do you like to participate in Club events and leagues in a relaxed and fun environment? Do you enjoy the benefits of having first choice of tee times? If so, then a full golf membership at The Wildewood Club is for you.

If a full golf membership isn't practical for you, a golf package may be the answer. We have a few different golf packages for you to choose from.

- The Ladies' Night Package (Girls Gone Wildewood) allows you to play any 12 Wednesday nights between 3:00 and 6:30 pm. The 9-hole package is \$200 including GST. The 18-hole package is \$350 including GST. You can book your tee-time up to 5 days in advance. You are eligible to play in the Ladies Opening and Closing events.
- There is a similar package for Men's Night which allows you to play any 12 Tuesday nights. The prices and conditions are the same as above.
- There is a third type of package that allows play after 10:00 am on weekdays and after noon on weekends and holidays, but not during Men's or Ladies' Nights. The costs are the same for 12 nine-hole games (\$200) or 12 eighteen-hole games (\$350) but bookings can be made only 2 days in advance.

All packages are available for purchase in the Golf Pro Shop.

Electric Cart Rentals

- Occasional electric cart rentals are purchased in the Golf Shop. The rates are \$18 for nine holes and \$30 for eighteen holes.
- A yearly electric cart rental is available to members for \$500 plus PST/GST, totalling \$560.00. This can be paid in the Club office. The yearly car rental entitles the member to unlimited use of the cart, including their spouse and non-member guests. If a member chooses to ride with the person who has paid for the yearly rental, they must pay the equivalent of a shared cart fee in the golf shop. Carts must be reserved ahead of time.

Many thanks to all of the members who have paid their golf fees by the deadline of April 1.

Statements will be going out soon to remind the rest of last year's golf members that this year's golf fees are now due.
